Sri Vaikunta Ekadasi

Friday, December 29th, 2017 - 8:00 AM - 7.45 PM



Vaikunta Ekadasi is one of the important and auspicious days to the Hindus. It is dedicated to Lord Vishnu. It occurs in the Hindu calendar, in the month of Margashirsha (Between December and January). Also called the 'Mukkoti Ekadasi', when observed, it bestows liberation from the cycle of birth and death. It is believed that 'Vaikunta Dwaram' or 'the gates to Lord's Inner Sanctum' are believed to be kept open for devotees.

This festival is being celebrated with the opening of special dwaram/entrance in the morning at the Shiva Vishnu Temple for devotees to seek the Lord Balaji.

Dwara puja will be performed in the morning followed by darshanam for devotees. In the evening, Lord Venkateshwara Sahasranama Homam will be performed.
