Karva Chauth Puja / Katha

Saturday, October 27th 2018

5:00 PM – 7:15 PM



The term 'Chauth' means the 'fourth day' (a reference to the fact that the festival falls on the fourth day of the dark-fortnight, or krishna paksh) and 'Karva' is an earthen pot with a spout - a symbol of peace and prosperity - that is necessary for the rituals. Hence the name 'Karva Chauth'. Karva Chauth' is a ritual of fasting observed by married Hindu women seeking the longevity, well-being and prosperity of their husbands. It is popular amongst married women in the northern and western parts of India. The Karva Chauth Puja will be held at the Livermore Temple on Thursday, October 27th 2018.
