JULY 9, 2016


WHEREAS, Yoga is an ancient physical, mental and spiritual practice from India that keeps the mind and body in balance and good health; and

WHEREAS, the first International Day of Yoga was celebrated in 2015 following a declaration by United Nations General Assembly; and




WHEREAS, the Shiva-Vishnu Temple is a leading Bay Area destination for Hindu cultural activities and provides much needed human services for local youth and seniors;




