

HCCC Guidelines for Devotees Visiting the Temple.

If you have any symptoms of cold, cough, or fever, you are not allowed in the temple. Please stay back at home.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the associated county regulations the temple hall is allowed to accommodate up to 50% of its capacity. Thank you for all your cooperation during these critical times.

1. Maintain Social Distance (Mandatory)

- a. Please maintain social distance at all times whenever you are amongst someone who is not part of your family or social bubble

2. Mask requirement (Mandatory)

- a. Masks are mandatory for all devotees over 2 years old.
- b. Cover coughs and sneezes.
- c. Avoid touching anything if you don't need to.

3. Parking your car

- a. Park in temple south parking lot only in the marked area for devotees.
- b. Proceed to the shoe rack area in front of the admin building to leave your footwear.
- c. We encourage you to leave your footwear in the car.
- d. Use the hand sanitizers in the shoe rack area.

4. Darshan

- a. Follow the guided path always maintaining social distance as marked.
- b. Family members can stand together on one spot.

5. Archanas and Abhishekams

- a. Do not interact with any priests.
- b. No personal archanas will be performed.
- c. Devotees are requested to sponsor at least an archana to help the temple financially through covid19 situation.
- d. Devotees can get archana tickets on website or in the Office.
- e. Priests will perform hourly archanas in the name of sponsoring devotees. Devotees will not be allowed to wait during archana.
- f. Abhishekam will be performed in the name of sponsoring devotees at scheduled time.

6. Personal Poojas

- a. No personal poojas will be performed inside the temple premises at this time.
- b. For personal poojas, book a room in the temple.

7. Theertam and Prasadam

- a. No Theertham or Prasadam will be distributed.

8. Car Poojas

- a. Car pooja can be performed in front of the office building.
- b. Get the ticket from the website or Office for suggested donation.

9. Donations are welcome and can be made

- a. On our website
- b. By calling the Office during temple hours at 925 449 6255.
- c. By visiting the office when you are in the temple premises.

10. Annadana

- a. Is being provided behind the temple in front of the Assembly Hall is food boxes on Saturdays and Sundays between 11am and 4pm.
- b. Do not consume the food on temple premises, please carry it home and eat it there.

11. Restroom access

- a. Only the admin building restrooms are accessible to devotees.
- b. Wash your hands thoroughly and dry with the air blower.

12. Facilities Rentals

- a. All Event Halls are available for rental.
- b. All the events are performed in line with restrictions laid down by the county. Please contact temple office for details.
- c. All social distancing and hygiene rules to be followed and enforced by guests.
- d. Temple Mahaprasadam is not being provided, however one can get their food catered.
- e. Additional charges of deep cleaning for the rented area after the event will apply.
